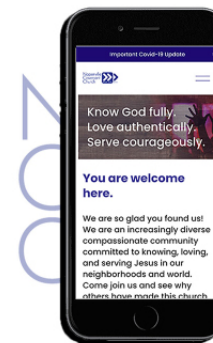
Knowing, Loving and Serving...
